## About Holy Communion

In Holy Communion, God's people gather as Jesus taught, united in what we believe. Sharing the beliefs and practices of the **Lutheran Church Missouri Synod (LCMS)**, we confess that this meal is more than a symbol. We confess (believe, speak, and live this truth):

- Jesus gives His true **body and blood** in the bread and wine of Holy Communion for the forgiveness of sins.
- God—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit—gives His gift of salvation in Baptism.
- We are sinners who need the gifts Jesus offers by His death and resurrection, as God promises in His inspired Word (the Bible).
- Holy Communion is something God gives His people as we gather for forgiveness and for the strength to live in God's Word by the Holy Spirit and to daily follow Jesus.

**Should I commune?** If you share this confession of faith, we welcome you to the table! If you have questions or hold different beliefs from those above, **we invite you to come forward for a blessing** (simply cross your arms over your chest). A pastor also would love to chat with you before or after the service to learn more.

## THE DAY OF PENTECOST



Last Sunday, we heard the story of the departure of Jesus at His ascension. And some ten days later from the Ascension, the day of Pentecost has arrived. It is the fiftieth day. It is the last day of Easter and the first day for the fruits of Christ's Easter victory to be proclaimed to the ends of the earth. Today we discover anew what it means to be united in the apostles' teaching, fellowship, the breaking of bread, and prayer. The disciples are gathered to bring the nations together as one people, and they share the Word of Christ's death and resurrection and the faith that apprehends and confesses this saving Truth. All of this is enabled by the fire of the Spirit burning in us and through us so that everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved!

We listen now to the account of Pentecost—a message recounting the action of the Holy Spirit, assuring us that as we are brought to faith in Christ, we receive the fullness of who we've been called to be.

# The Pentecost Account

Acts 2:1–21



## WE TURN TO GOD, MINDFUL OF OUR SINFULNESS

*Confession of Sins*  
(John 16:7-8; Romans 10:13)

P: Jesus said, *"I tell you the truth: it is to your advantage that I go away, for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you. But if I go, I will send Him to you..."*

**C: "And when He comes, He will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment."**

P: Let us then pray to the Spirit, our Helper and Advocate, who intercedes on our behalf:

Holy Spirit, Lord and giver of life, Your presence among us unifies us as one Body.

**C: Yet we have belittled and neglected our brothers and sisters.**

P: You have been poured out that we might bear witness to Christ, our Savior.

**C: But too often, we remain silent.**

P: You were sent to produce in us the fruit of righteousness.

**C: Yet we have displayed our negative, discontented, and selfish natures.**

P: For these things, and for those unspoken, we plead to God our Father to forgive us for the sake of Jesus Christ.

**C: Holy Spirit, grant us power to bear witness to our Savior, Jesus, in all we say and do. Bring to light in us the fruit of righteousness, and hold us united in faith unto life everlasting. Amen.**

*(We observe a moment of quiet reflection as we consider our own sinful condition)*

## CHRIST'S WORDS ESTABLISH THE LORD'S SUPPER

*Words of Institution*
