Tuition is assessed to maintain this excellent level of education, which remains highly competitive among private Christian schools in Washtenaw County. An investment in this education is an investment in each child's future.

Understanding that our school's average education costs \$9,400 per student, we take proactive steps to assist our community. Through the SPAA tuition assistance funding model, no student tuition is the full amount, ensuring that education remains a reachable goal for every family. Additional assistance is available based on the availability of funds and the need for those funds.

Annual Enrollment Fee

\$215 for the first student and \$100 for each additional student. The enrollment fee covers the annual cost of FACTS School Information System and PTL dues for each family, along with a theme year t-shirt, yearbook, and student activities for each student.
