

SPECIAL DRESS DAY INFORMATION

WHAT ARE SPECIAL DRESS DAYS?

Special dress days are Fridays (or the last school day of the week) every
week of the school year. Each Friday has a specific theme. Students may
wear the theme day attire (red for Valentine's Day, Christmas attire, etc.) or
St. Paul gear with jeans. If they choose not to dress in the theme or St. Paul
gear, they must remain in dress code attire. No leggings or
athletic/sweatpants will be worn on special dress days unless specified.

HOW DO SPECIAL DRESS DAYS WORK?

- Each week has a different theme.
- Each theme will be shared via the Enews the week of or in teacher newsletters.

ALWAYS ACCEPTED THEME:

- St. Paul Gear Day
 - Any St. Paul gear, including theme T-shirts from the current year or the previous year
 - Any St. Paul VBS shirts
 - Any Attire from our spirit store from any year

CLOTHING:

- Clothing should be clean and appropriate
- No Sweatpants, athletic pants, or leggings allowed unless specifically stated per the theme
